Musical Term	Definition
Dynamics	the volume of the music, usually described in terms of loud / quiet
Improvisation	music invented as you go along
Lyrics	the words of a song
Metre	the grouping of beats into twos, threes, fours etc
Ostinato	a short rhythmic or melodic pattern that is repeated over and over (also called a 'riff')

Jerusalem by Hubert Parry

The words are from a poem by William Blake.

'Jerusalem' is Blake's metaphor for his vision of a Heaven in England, contrasting with the 'dark Satanic mills' of the Industrial Revolution.

The lyrics comment on the change from a rural to an industrialised landscape.
