All clubs start in the w/c 1st June with final sessions in the second from last week of the half term. The cost for each club is £33. Please book before the first session to avoid a £5 registration fee.

Please register and pay online directly:

1. Visit the Sporting Trust web shop: Sporting87EducationalTrust.org/shop
2. Scroll down and click on the products called “St Edmunds Primary School xxx Club”.
3. Enter **your child’s details** and click on “Add to basket”.
4. Click “Proceed to check out”.
5. If you’re new to the Sporting Trust, you’ll then be asked to enter **your contact details**.
6. Tick the **terms and conditions box**, and click on “Pay securely with Stripe”.

Children must bring a bottle of water to all clubs. KS1 and KS2 Footballers must wear shin pads. KS2 children must also wear football boots when the ground is wet (training shoes are acceptable when the ground is firm). KS1 Footballers will be on the MUGA and so must wear training shoes (not studded boots). If you have questions, please contact me.

To complement school footy club you may like to consider our beginners **Footy Cubs and Tigers** (Yrs R,1 & 2) or advanced **Academy** sessions (Yrs 3-6). Occasionally we are also able to offer places in Sporting 87 FC teams (we do have waiting lists but St Edmund's School footy club children are given priority).
