Half Termly Learning overview: Summer 2

Year 6

This is a summary of the learning taking place for the half term beginning: 01.06.26

Not every subject listed is taught every week.

Subject		Learning
English	Reading	Short texts will be used to develop accurate reading at the correct pace. The children will also use the texts to improve comprehension and vocabulary development. Class readers: Windrush Child; Goodnight, Mister Tom/Friend or Foe.
	Writing	Persuasive writing: the children will be learning how to structure a persuasive text, linking to our learning in humanities.
Maths		The children will complete project-based learning on the theme of baking. They will work out recipe conversions and establish the best value supermarket for the items needed.
Religious Education		Children will explore the common good, looking at ways to promote unity and love. They will learn about the central beliefs of Sikhism and link ideas across Catholic social teaching principles.
Science		The class will learn about evolution and inheritance. They will learn about important scientists in the advance of evolutionary thinking and how genes affect our development.
History		Battle of Britain. Children will conclude this year's learning by focussing on the Battle of Britain. They will learn key dates and events and the outcome of the Battle of Britain's impact on Britain's and the Allies' victory.
PSHE		Weekly topics linked to assembly themes including UNICEF Rights of the Child. Children will learn about relationships and sex education following our programme which is based on the teaching of the Catholic church with regard to marriage and relationships
Primary Languages- French (KS2 only)		The children will finalise their French transition project ready for sending on to their new secondary school and will do final revisions of opinions, shopping and phonics.
Art & Design		Printing. Lino prints. To apply an understanding of composition to plan a print and to develop drawn ideas through printmaking.
Computing		The children will be learning and practising typing skills using 'Typing Club'.
Music		The class will be rehearsing songs for our end of year production.
PE		Outdoor Adventurous Activities- the children will engage in outdoor activities that challenge and promote physical and mental development. Striking and Fielding – cricket and rounders.
