**Half Termly Learning overview: Summer 2**

**Year: Early Years**

This is a summary of the learning taking place for the half term beginning: 1.6.26

Not every subject listed is taught every week.

Subject		Learning - Where would you like to go on holiday and how will you get there?
<b>Communication and Language</b>		Make comments about what they have heard and ask relevant questions to clarify their understanding. Express their ideas using past, present and future tenses eg, I went, I go, I will be going. Use 'and, but and because' to extend their sentence.
<b>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</b>		Show independence, resilience and perseverance when trying something new. Show sensitivity to others needs.
<b>Physical Development inc Forest School</b>		Move around the field and playground safely when running, jumping, skipping and hopping. Demonstrate coordination and accuracy when throwing a beanbag into a hoop. Investigate the importance of water and changes in our environment.
<b>Religious Education</b>		Recognise that we are all special and different and that we are all part of God's family, the Church. Meet a member of our Parish and talk to them about their faith. Find out about another faith.
<b>Literacy</b>	<b>Reading</b>	Key Texts – Billy Goats Gruff. Segment and blend words to read simple sentences.
	<b>Writing</b>	Writing simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others. Write recognisable letters with correct size and orientation
<b>Maths</b>		Automatically recall number bonds to 10 eg $6+4=10$ $9+1=10$ Know double facts to 10 eg $2+2=4$ $3+3=6$ Identify odd and even numbers
<b>Understanding of the World</b>		Recognise similarities and differences between the rivers Lark in BSE, the Nile and the Amazon. Look at different maps and talk about places we have been to or would like to visit.
<b>Expressive Arts and Design</b>		Build a bridge, raft and vehicle and explain the process of how you made it. Learn, sing and perform songs using percussion instruments to accompany the songs.
