### Half Termly Learning overview: Summer 2 Year: 4

This is a summary of the learning and taking place for the half term beginning: 1<sup>st</sup> June

Not every subject listed is taught every week.

Subject		Learning
English	Reading	Independent Reading (15 mins a day) Class reader: 4C- A series of unfortunate events, 4BF- The lion, the witch and the wardrobe. Guided Reading: Children will look through a variety of different texts such as poems, short stories, articles and letters and practice retrieving information from the text
	Writing	<b>Persuasive texts</b> - Children will be exploring a variety of different persuasive texts before creating one of their own. <b>Dialogue</b> - Children will be focusing on how to correctly use speech and dialogue in a variety of texts.
Maths		<b>Shape</b> - Understanding and identifying angles, polygons with a focus on triangles and quadrilaterals. <b>Statistics</b> - Comparing and understanding different charts.
Religious Education		<b>Branch Six: Dialogue and Encounter:</b> Describe some facts about the life of St Paul and explain why he is an important figure for Christians. Describe some ways Christians in their local area work together for the benefit of the whole community (or the common good). Recount some facts about a different liturgical rite within the Catholic Church. Recognise some reasons why different liturgical traditions arose in different parts of the world.
Science		<b>Animals and Living Things</b> - Children will be revisiting this topic, looking at different groups of vertebrates and invertebrates.
History		<b>Ancient Egypt</b> - Children will be learning about ancient civilisations, Egyptian gods, the old, new and middle kingdom and a variety of different pharaohs throughout the different kingdoms. They will also discuss the importance of the Nile to Egyptian civilisation.
Geography		NA.
PSHE		Healthy Relationships – Children will learn about how to build and maintain positive relationships with peers. Managing Change – Children will learn different way of managing change and embracing change.
Primary Languages- French (KS2 only)		The children will learn to name clothing and will describe what they wear using a variety of adjectives, opinion phrases and time phrases.
Art & Design inc Design Technology		Electrical systems- Applying scientific understanding of electrical circuits through designing and making a torch using recycled and reclaimed materials
Computing		<b>Creating Videos</b> - Children will learn about creating videos. They will film and edit in groups.
Music		<b>Cornets</b> – To continue our work on the different notes, and start learning some more complex pieces ready for the WCET Festival.
