Subject		Learning
English	Reading	We will be focusing on a variety of genres including narrative texts. Each week the children will have questions to answer based on that class text. I encourage the children to answer in full sentences.
	Writing inc spellings	Narrative Texts: - Understand which features are found in a narrative text - Writing in appropriate tenses - Understanding use of paragraphs - How to use descriptive language
Maths		<u>Place Value</u> - Hundreds, tens, ones - Represent/Partition numbers to. 1000 - Represent numbers/Partition numbers to 10,000 - Find 1,,10,100 or 1,000 more or less - Number Line to 1000/10,000 - Estimate and Compare & Order Numbers - Round to the nearest 10,100,1000 - Roman Numerals <u>Addition and Subtraction</u> - Add and subtract 1s, 10s, 100s and 1,000s, including crossing boundaries - Add two 4-digit numbers (with and without exchange) - Subtract two 4-digit numbers (with and without exchange) - Add and subtract numbers with different digits - Use complements to 100 and 1,000 - Estimate answers using rounding and place value
Religious Education		<u>Branch 1 - Creation and Covenant</u> Revisit the Creation story- use of symbolism to explain the relationship between God, humans & the world The 'holy' day. The Holy Trinity. (Gen 1 -2)
Science		<u>Rocks</u> - How are rocks formed - What type of rocks are there - Can rocks change - What makes soil? - How Fossils are formed
Geography		<u>Map and fieldwork- Human and Physical Features</u> The children will learn about: - What are the 8 points on a compass - Where are physical and human features located in this place

	- What human and physical features can you identify on a map? - Children will work with compasses, maps, atlases and digital mapping tools throughout this unit
PSHE	The children will learn about: - Ready Respectful Safe- how can we show we are RRS in our school and classroom - Democracy- International Day of Democracy - International Day of Peace/ United Nations- European Day of Languages - Harvest Festival- Why do we celebrate - Keeping Mentally Healthy - Black History Month - Rights and Responsibilities- UN Childrens Charter
Primary Languages- French (KS2 only)	The children will find out about the importance of learning a language and of getting to know other cultures; they will find out facts about France and will revise useful phrases, basic questions & answers and simple topic words such as numbers and colours.
Music	Children will be learning Violin every Friday
Art & Design inc Design Technology	<u>Urban Art: Expressing ideas through designing/drawing</u> Pupils will study murals and street paintings when learning about contemporary street art. They will consider graffiti in the context of lettering artforms and learn how to draw street art graphics before designing their own composition for a community space artwork.
Computing	<u>Computing Systems and networks- The Internet</u> Children will: -Explore networks share messages with another network to form the internet -How the internet lets us view the world wide web -Analyse a website and identify key parts -Explore who owns the content on the world wide web -Gain an appreciation of the fact not everything seen on internet is true, honest or accurate
PE	<u>Indoors: Hockey</u> - How to dribble with control - How to pass accurately - How to keep possession as a team - How to defend safely - How to apply skills in small-sided games <u>Outdoors: Gymnastics:</u> - How to hold basic shapes with control - How to balance safely on different body parts - How to travel in different ways - How to link actions smoothly - How to work safely on floor and low apparatus
