Related Facts Matching

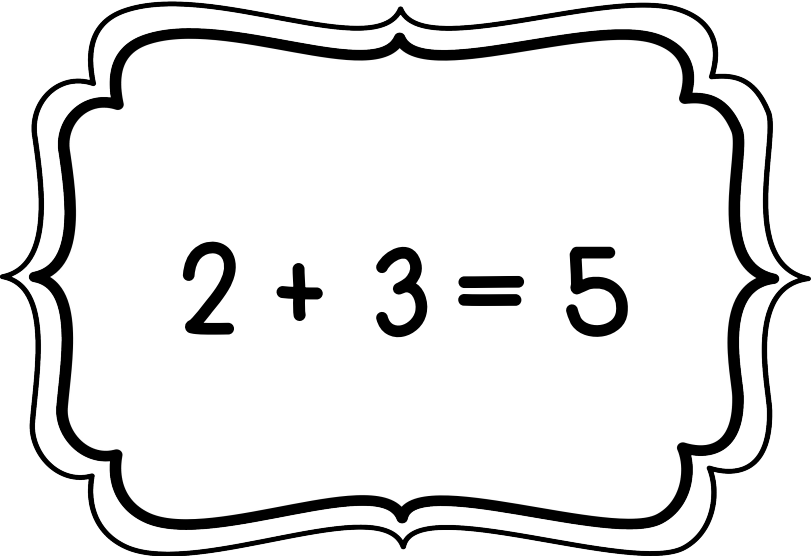
2 sets of cards have been included. One set has the answers of the number sentence. The other set requires the students to read the number sentence and figure out the sum or difference.

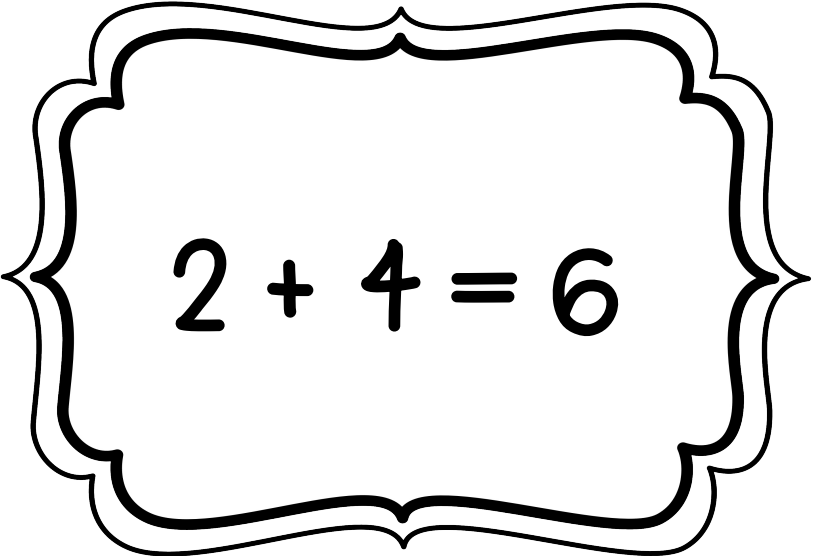
Buddy Match

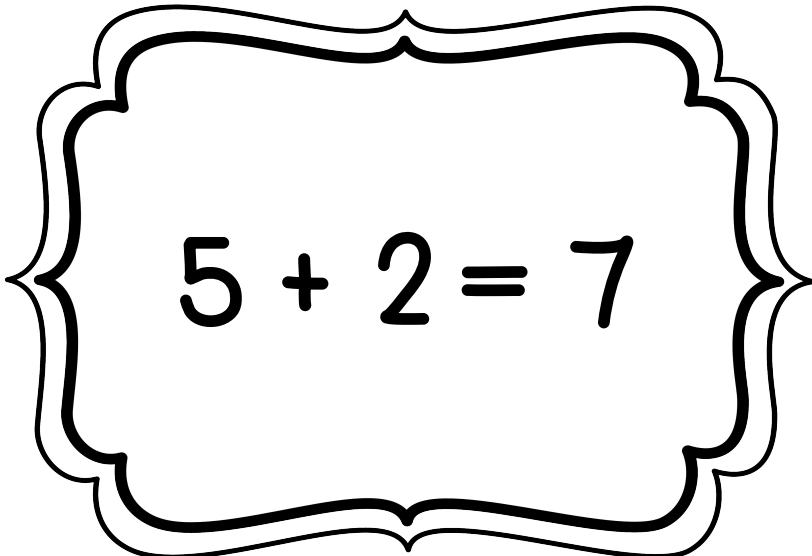
- One set of cards is needed to play. Laminate for durability.
- Give each student a card. Students must walk around the room and find their related fact buddy/match.
- Students should use the language, "I have $3 + 4 = 7$. Do you have $7 - 3 = 4$?" Or "I have $9 - 3 = 6$. Do you have $3 + 6 = 9$?"
- Once students have successfully found their buddy, they stand next to one another.
- After all students have found their related fact buddy, go around the room and have each pair share their related addition and subtraction facts.

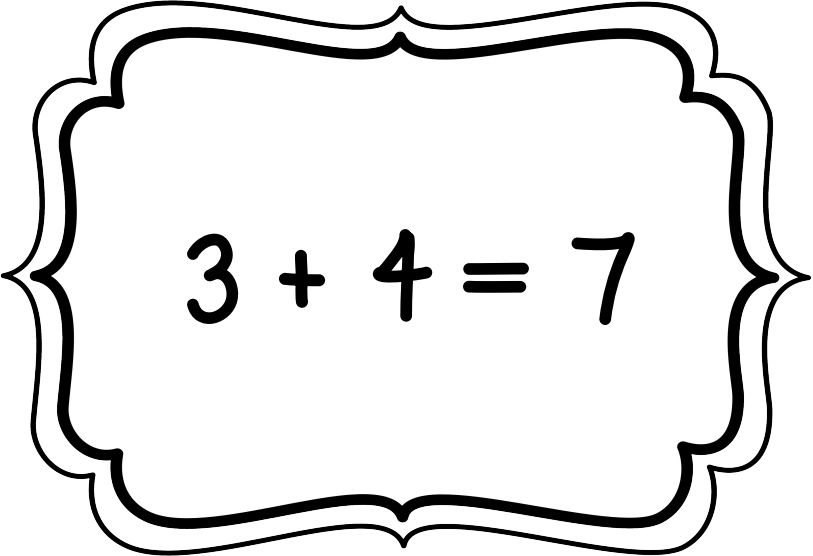
Memory or Matching

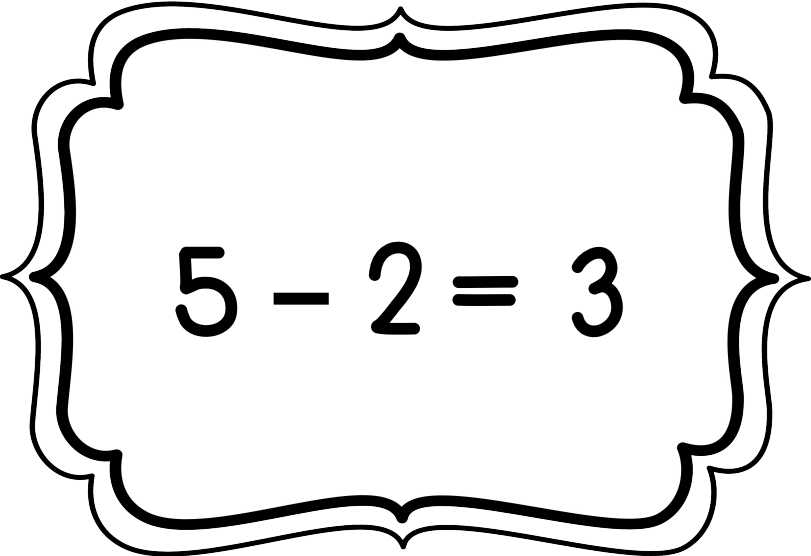
- Each group of students needs a set of cards. Copy on cardstock.
- Students play in pairs or groups. Cards are arranged in rows face down.
- The first player turns over a card and reads the math fact. Then they turn over a second card and read the math fact. If the cards are related addition and subtraction facts, they keep the cards. If not, the cards are turned back over.
- Play continues with each player.
- The game is over when all cards have been successfully matched.
- Students should record their matches on the recording sheet.

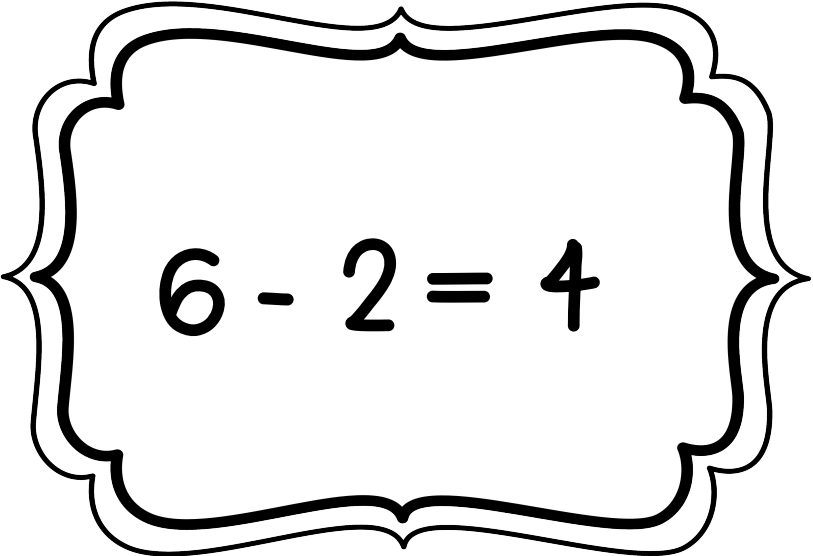
