distening to, discussing and expressing views about a wide range of poetry, stories and non-fiction at a level beyond that at which they ad independently mation are related
becoming increasingly familiar with and retelling a wider range of ories, fairy stories and traditional tales ways
recognising simple recurring language in stories and poetry
discussing and clarifying the meanings of words, linking new mean-
discussing their favourite words and phrases
continuing to build up a repertoire of poems learnt by heart, reciting some, with appropriate intonation to make the meaning clear
understand both the books that they can already read accurately and fluand those that they listen to by: and vocabulary provided by the teacher
checking that the text makes sense to them as they read and correcting inaccurate reading
making inferences on the basis of what is being said and done
answering and asking questions
predicting what might happen on the basis of what has been read
Discuss books, poems and other works that are read to them and those that they can read for themselves, taking turns and listening to what othexplain and discuss their understanding of books, poems and other material, both those that they listen to and those that they read for themselves.
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
