<u>**Palm Sunday</u>** – is the Sunday before Easter. On this day Jesus' entry into Jerusalem is celebrated by people who carry branches of palms.</u>

<u>Holy Water</u> - this water has been blessed by a priest and is used in religious ceremonies.

<u>Ash Wednesday</u> – This is the first day of lent and is marked by services of penitence.

<u>Lent</u> - this includes forty weekdays from Ash Wednesday to Holy Saturday. This time is for fasting and penitence. <u>Fasting</u> - when we do not eat or drink.

<u>**Penitence**</u> – when we show we are sorry or regretful for something we have done.

<u>New Covenant</u> - The agreement between God and the followers of Christ.
