Commandments- the rules that we should live by.

Contract- To make a legal agreement with someone.

Covenant- An agreement based on trust and faith a promise.

Faithful- to continue to support

Holy Communion- When we receive the body and blood of Jesus Christ

Incarnation-God came from Heaven and was made man

New Covenant- through Jesus' death and resurrection everyone on earth can enter into a new agreement to 'Love the God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbour as yourself.'
