Half Termly Learning overview: Year 3 Abraham Class – Summer 1

This is a summary of the learning and taking place for the half term beginning: 16th April 2024

Not every subject listed is taught every week.

| Subject | | Learning |
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| English | Reading | The children's class read this half-term will be 'The Twits' by Roald Dahl. In guided reading, they will be looking at a variety of text types. The children will also be carrying out 15 minutes of independent daily reading. |
| | Writing | The children will be exploring the features of narrative myths and creating their own work based on this. Then children will also be rehearsing and refining a range of grammatical features related to these text types. |
| Maths | | The children will be adding and subtracting fractions, solving problems involving money, learning to tell time to the nearest minute and calculating time using time intervals. |
| Religious Education | | The children will be exploring the events of Easter and Pentecost, and the importance of these celebrations to the Church. |
| Science | | The children will be learning about the animals, including humans: about their diets, their systems for survival (respiratory, circulatory, digestive, nervous and muscle) and the functions of the human skeleton. |
| History | | The children will be learning about the Romans, who they were, their invasion of Britain and how their beliefs and technologies developed during this time. |
| Geography | | Not this half term. |
| Music | | The theme of this half term's Music is the Human body, the children will be focusing on musical structure - call and response, word rhythms, singing in 2 parts and binary form. |
| Primary Languages- French (KS2 only) | | The children will learn numbers to 31, days of the week, months and seasons and will eventually learn how to say and recognise a full date in French. |
| Art & Design incl. Design Technology | | The children will be looking at the theme of Sculpture and 3D: Abstract shape & space. |
| Computing | | The children will be learning about computer networks – how devices communicate with one another, how networks help with collaboration and the importance of network security. |
| PE | | The children will be learning to create and choreograph short dance performances on the theme of Machines. We will be learning to swim and improving our swimming. |
